## the periodic table of OIJR'ANI CHAPTERS

It is reported that RasūlAllāh said: I was given the **Seven Long Chapters** [Sabá al-Ţuwal] in place of the Torah; and I was given **Centums** [Mi'ūn] in place of the Gospel [Injīl]; and I was given the **Iteratives** [Mathānīy] in place of Psalms [Zabūr] and I was additionally bestowed the **Sectioned** ones [Mufaşşal].





Al-Sabá al-Ţuwal: The Seven Lengthy Chapters



Al-Mi'ūn: The Centums - Surahs with more than 100 verses



Al-Mathānīy: The Iteratives - Less than 100 verses; until Sūrah Hujurat





Al-Mufaşşal-: The Sectioned - from Sūrah Qaf onwards until Nas. These are in the last 4 parts [juz']

## Qur'an chapters are grouped as follows, based on hadith

- 1. The Seven Lengthy Chapters [Sabá al-Ţuwal]: αl-Baqarah, Aāl Ímrān, αl-Nisā'a, αl-Mā'idah, al-Anáām, al-Aárāf and Yūnus or Barā'ah [Sūrah al-Tawbah].
- 2. The Centums [Mi'ūn]: Chapters containing over a hundred verses or nearly as many.
- 3. The Iteratives [Mathāniy]: Chapters that contain fewer than one hundred verses and are named as such because they feature recurring stories.
- 4. The Sectioned [Mufassal]: They were named mufassal sectioned due to their frequent sectioning or terminations; i.e. they are short chapters. Also known as Muĥkam: Operationals, because there are no abrogated verses in these chapters.

- 3. Magāṣīr The Dwellings: Chapters that start with the Praise of Allāh (al-Ĥāmidāt). §1 §6 §18 §34 §35
- 4. Árā'is The Brides: Chapters that start with Glorifying Allāh سَبِّحَ لِلهُ [al-Musabbiĥāt]. §17 §57 §59 §61 §62 §64 §87
- 5. Dayābīj The Silk Brocades: Chapters that start with  $\hat{H}\bar{a}$ -Mīm.  $\stackrel{$40 \ $41 \ $42 \ $43 \ $44 \ $45}{}$
- 6. Riyād The Lush Gardens: Short chapters from §50 to §114 [Juz' 27-30]
